

# Revelation 15:1-8

## Introduction:

Seven angels prepare to pour out seven more judgements upon the earth. John hears the victors over the Antichrist singing a song to praise to God.

- I. What John Sees (15:1-2a, 5-8)
  - A. He sees seven **angels** (15:1-2a, 6-7)
    1. Their **assignment** (15:1, 7): They are to pour out God's final judgement, consisting of seven wrath-filled vials.
    2. Their **appearance** (15:6): They are dressed in clean, shining linen and wear golden sashes around their chests.
  - B. He sees a sea of fire and glass, upon which stand those who have been victorious over the Antichrist (15:2a)
  - C. He sees a smoke-filled **Temple** (15:5, 8)
    1. The entrance to the Holy of Holies is opened (15:5)
    2. The Temple itself is closed to all until the vial judgements are completed. (15:8)
- II. What John Hears (15:2b-4): He hears **singing**.
  - A. The singers (15:2b): Those who have been victorious over the Antichrist.
  - B. The song (15:3-4): It is the song of **Moses**, praising God for His justice, eternity, holiness and righteousness.
